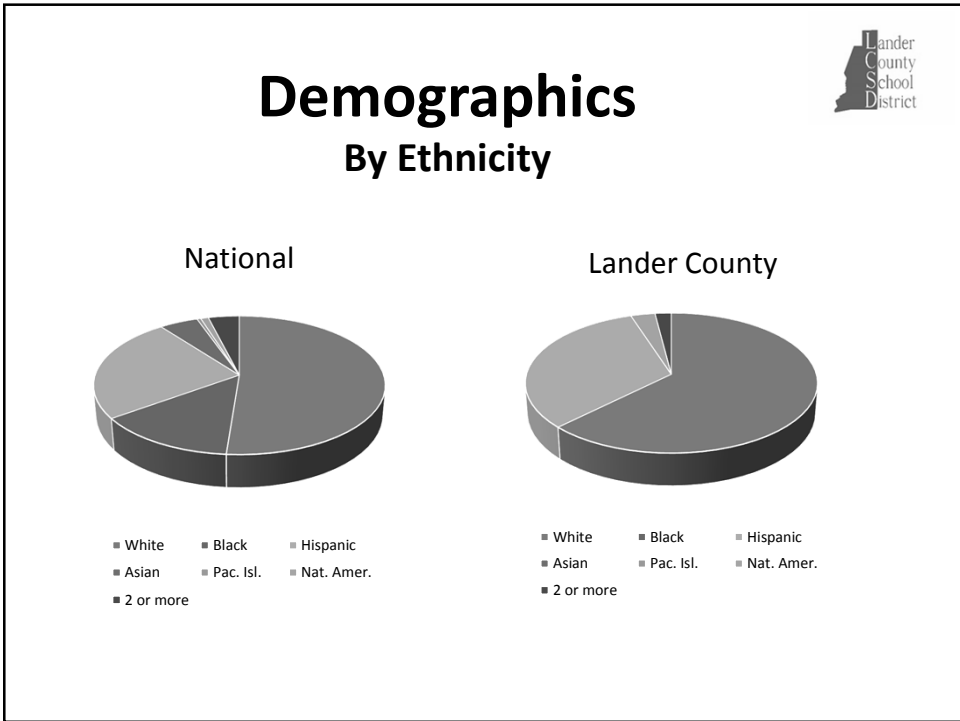
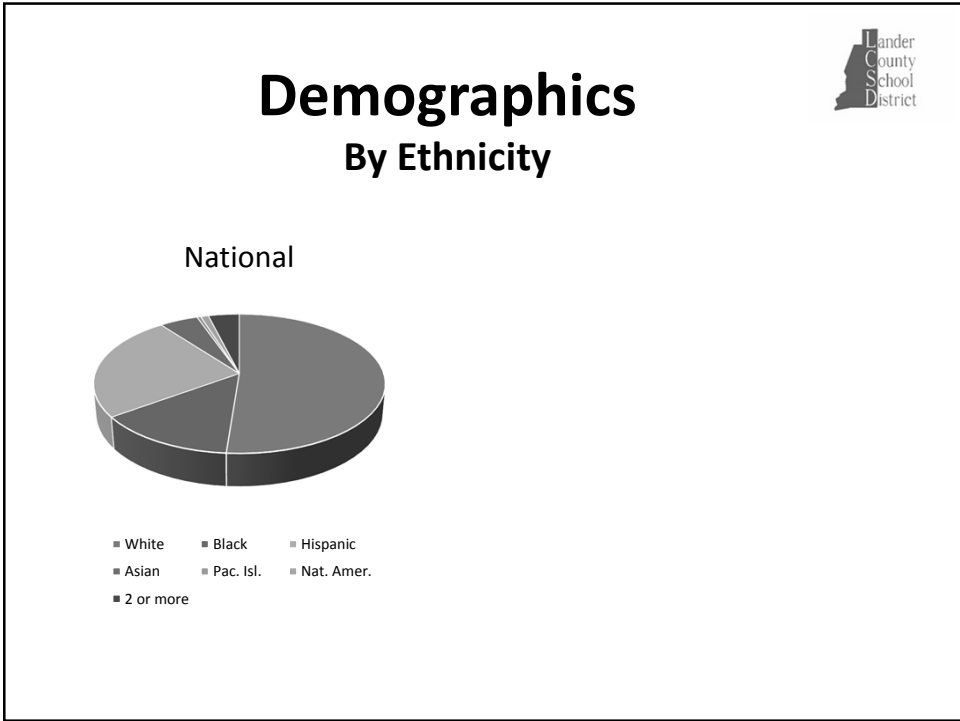

Demographics By Ethnicity



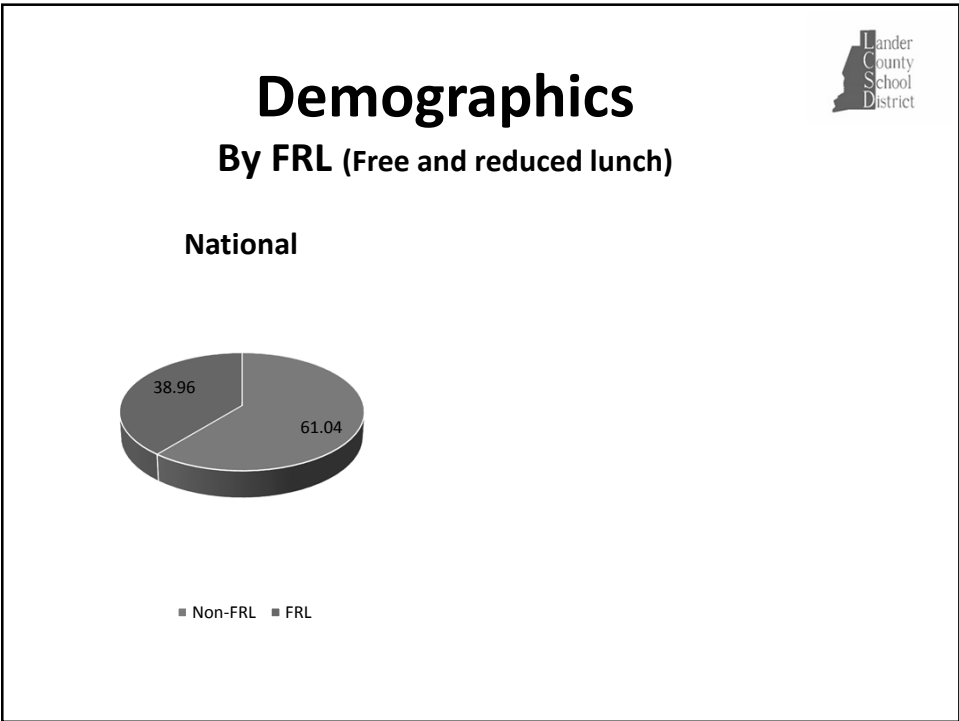



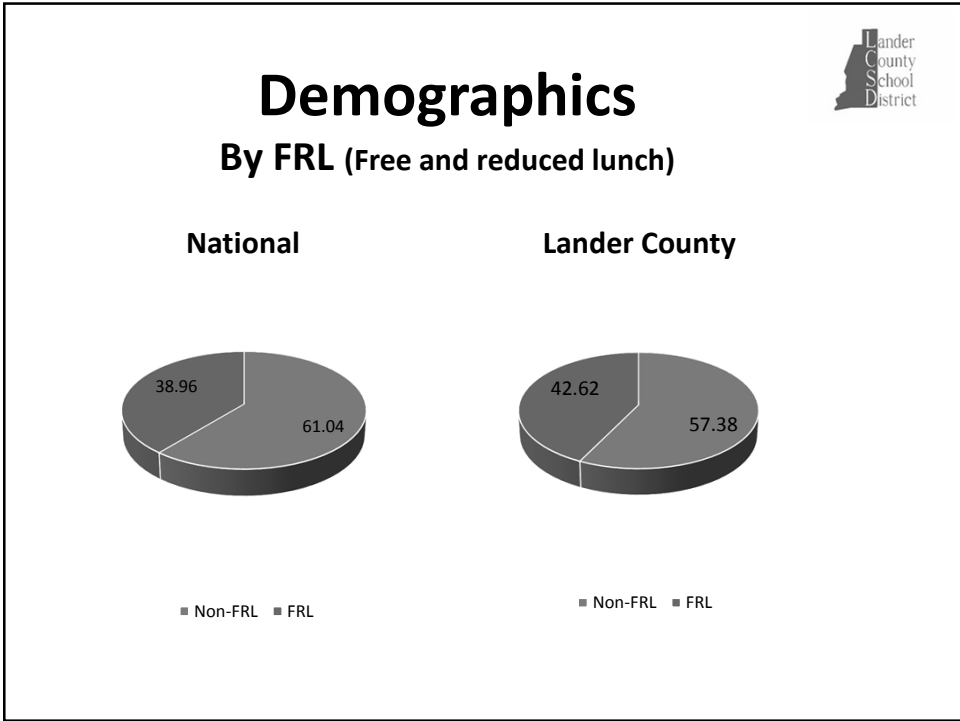
